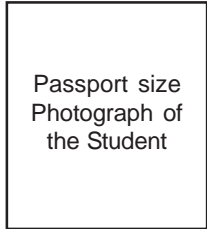

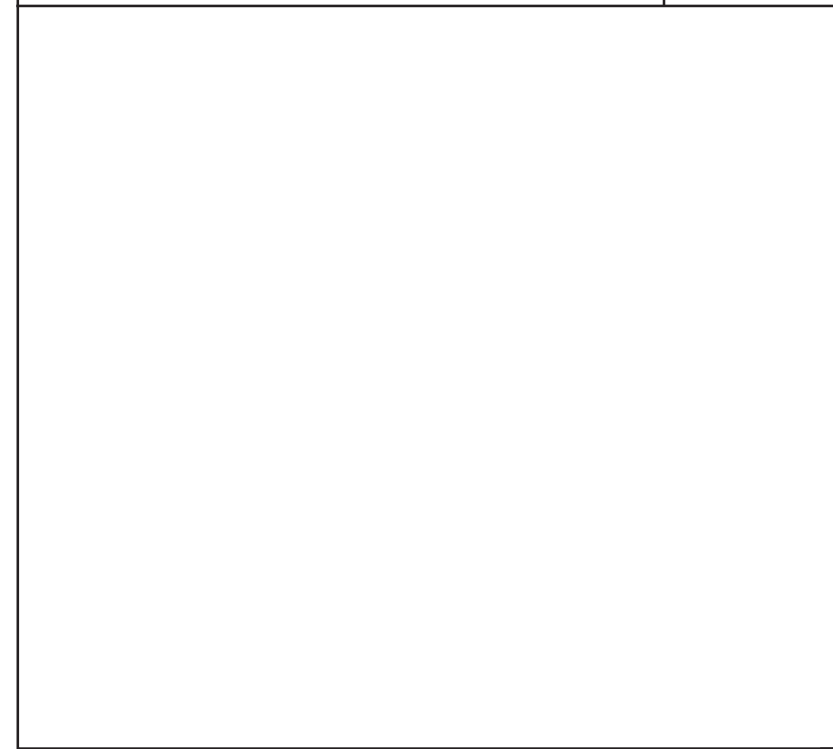

FEE REGULATIONS
